Afghani #1 Regular is the stereotypical spokesplant for Indica: easy and fast to grow, robust, wide stature, and packed with flower sites. This strain of cannabis will relax you even in small doses. Beginners or expert growers can't go wrong with this cannabis strain. If you're looking for a sticky cannabis strain with good yields, this is it.

Cannabis indica may take its name from the country India, but the best Indica strains originated in the [mountains of Afghanistan](#). Old school growers call these marijuana strains Afghanica or Hash Plant. As the name implies, they form the basis of high-quality afghani hashish. Fortunately, you don't have to jump on a plane to enjoy this middle eastern strain, simple order a few Afghani #1 Regular cannabis seeds from [regularmarijuanaseeds.com](#).

The best phenotypes of the parenting plants of our Afghani seeds have been distilled into a virulent seed strain that delivers prime examples of the Indica genotype every grow. Growers who want a fast-growing indoor cannabis strain with good yields and high resin production will love these afghani seeds. Whether you want consistent harvests from your seed investment or pure Afghani mother plants for clones, Afghani seeds Regular is the perfect solution!

You can expect wide low stature, robust, plants with strong branching and a ton of foliage. Give them at least eight weeks in the vegetative stage to maximize your results. The flowering phase lasts about seven to eight weeks. Height growth is limited, as is typical with most all Indica strains.

When the sticky resin-coated buds and pistils gradually turn orange, you will know that it is ready to chop. The plant will look like a large bouquet extending from the main stem into a single, resin-covered flower cluster. The smaller buds, while tiny will boost your final yield, so make sure you dry them also.

After drying and curing you will have large, compact, heavy buds that held their weight even after drying.

Afghani seeds Regular are very simple to grow, but you should remember that this strain is bred for indoor cannabis grow rooms. These plants will only thrive in an outdoor setting if you have a Mediterranean climate with hot summers.

Effect, flavor and smell of Afghani #1 Regular

Because Afghani #1 has a long-lasting psychoactive and body effect, it is very well suited for an evening on the sofa. The sedating stone effect should not be underestimated. Novices may find it puts them to sleep.

For other consumers, the combination of a feel-good sense of relaxation will be a welcome evening accompaniment. Make sure you check to make sure you have a few snacks to hand before consuming.

The aroma of this old-school traditional strain, comprising earthy tones and notes of fruits and pepper, will transport cannabis smokers back to their first hashish experiences.
